BENEFITS OF TPC



1 ATHLETE PRE & POST EVALUATION

to measure physical agility, speed and strength for each player. This allows for an objective measurement of our program's impact and tracks the individual athlete's progress. Individual results will be emailed to parents after both the pre and post tests and team summaries will be provided to Bloomington Youth Hockey at the conclusion of the season.

2 DRYLAND TRAINING

will focus on mobility, strength, power, speed and overall conditioning. Drills utilized will have elements of multi-dimensional speed and movement to improve the unique skill set of hockey athletes. Special emphasis will be programmed to concentrate on the hips, glutes and lower body of the athletes. The goal of dryland training is to develop your athlete in parallel with on ice training.

3 TRAINING FEE DISCOUNT

is significant and includes an additional multiple year discount resulting in less than \$8 per session per athlete.

4 TEAM BONDING

dynamic is strengthened during dryland training sessions as athletes can easily encourage teammates, build rapport, increase communication and work towards a common goal of improved team performance. TPC cultivates an environment that fosters team comradery and individual confidence.
