### **Parent/Spectators**

#### Conduct Expectations for Parents/Spectators and Responsive Measures for Inappropriate Parent/Spectator Conduct

A game will be stopped by on-ice officials when the parents/spectators display inappropriate or disruptive behavior which interferes with other parents/spectators or the game. This inappropriate and disruptive behavior includes, but is not limited to:

- Use of obscene or vulgar language in a boisterous manner to anyone at any time.
- Taunting of players, coaches, officials or other spectators by means of baiting, ridiculing, threat of physical violence or physical violence.
- Throwing of any object in the spectators viewing area, players bench, penalty box or on ice surface, directed in any manner as to create a safety hazard.

The on-ice officials will identify violators to the coaches for the purpose of removing parents/spectators from the parents'/spectators' viewing and game area. Once removed, play will resume. Lost time will not be replaced. Violators will incur a minimum mandatory 3-game suspension given by the Falcons Rules and Ethics Committee from that team's games and may be subject to further disciplinary action by the local governing body (league and State) and the Falcons Rules and Ethics Committee. These actions are not eligible for appeal.

No matter why a parent/spectator is asked to leave by an official, by the rink personnel, or by a Falcons Coach/Board Member **the parent/spectator will be restricted/suspended from attendance for a minimum of 3 games** involving the team in which the parent/spectator is affiliated. Reporting of an incident of inappropriate conduct by a parent/spectator involves the following process, or something similar to the following process:

An official will file an electronic "Incident Report" detailing the official's version of the occurrence with the AHAI R&E Committee. The Committee sends the report to the spectator's club in order for the club to conduct an investigation. Upon completion of the spectator's club investigation (that should include talking to the accused spectator) the investigating club will report back to the AHAI R&E Committee for final approval of the minimum 3-game suspension or any additional imposed suspension.
