

Varsity Overview

Continuing tradition that former Tiger Wrestling teams have started is no easy feat. The 2018-19 Wrestling Team challenged themselves to reach the accomplishments of past Tigers. Not only did they reach these accomplishments, but in some cases surpassed them. Numerous off-season hours played a large role in this success.

This year's hard work and effort propelled the Tiger's to roll through the Southwestern Conference duals untouched, claiming the title for the 8th consecutive year. This was another year that the key ingredient of depth was displayed. 29 wrestlers lettered this year, showing off the multitude of great wrestlers we have and that it takes to win the Conference again. The Tigers were also great in tournament action, bringing the "Fox" Tournament championship trophy back to Edwardsville. Best ever finishes at the "Dvorak" (4th) and "Cheesehead" (7th) Invitational occurred, also. Also for the first time ever, the JR Varsity participated in two Varsity Tournaments, and three dual meets, winning the Championship at the Mt. Olive Tournament. Included in the season honors was our post – season success, with our 8th straight regional Championship. Included in this success was breaking the string of Team Sectional losses by beating Lincoln Way West with Will Zupanci's exciting finish, and leading to an ELITE 8 in the STATE finish. Individually the Tigers sent 5 individuals (Reynolds, Moss, Matarelli, Odom, Surtin) to the State Tournament, which is the most since the three class era. Noah Surtin made his second consecutive Grand march placing 2nd, and a school record 3 state places. Lloyd Reynolds memorable run to get on the "Stand" showed truly what "Tiger Style" is all about.

This year the Tigers had 6 Senior wrestlers, all representing their school, team, and parents well, and contributed greatly to their team's success. Noah and Josh led their team in different but effective styles, both winning a ton of big matches. Sam Martin displayed unheralded courage, wrestling through a torn ACL, mostly for his teammates. Sam Clark - stepping up and contributing with big wins, and unmatched toughness. Connor was always ready to step in to help his team win, and was a great role model for the younger wrestlers. Jack earned his 3rd consecutive letter, but was probably known best for being an outstanding teammate. There have undoubtedly been many friendships made throughout their wrestling career, and special moments that will never be forgotten. "Remember the Journey" as all of the ups and downs are all learning experiences that will help you in your future endeavors. It's been a great ride, please remember, once a Tiger Wrestler – Always a Tiger Wrestler.

With such a valuable Senior group, filling the holes left by them will be a tremendous task. Although we are losing 6 lettermen, the talent that remains in the Tiger Wrestling room is enough to provide another year of excitement. This can only be accomplished by hard work and dedication that past Tiger Wrestlers have endured. We need to continue to work hard, and remember what got us to the success we have had. 2018-2019 Junior Varsity Season Overview

The junior varsity team had another outstanding season for our program. These young men worked extremely hard all year long. If they work hard this off-season **Tiger Wrestling** will continue to do great things in the future. Each of these young men should be proud of what they accomplished no matter what their individual records were. As their coach I am proud of what they were able to achieve as a team.

This year's junior varsity team had an undefeated dual meet record of 21-0. They were **JV CONFERENCE CHAMPIONS** again this season with the help of many freshmen in the lineup along the way. The team also competed in four tournaments this season: Mehlville JV Duals (1st Place/16 Teams), Mt. Olive Varsity Tournament (1st Place/15 Teams), Quincy Notre Dame Varsity Tournament (3rd Place/15 teams) and the annual SWC JV Dual Team Tournament (1st Place).

After starting the season 9-0 in duals the team competed at the Mehlville JV Dual Tournament over Christmas break where they defeated five teams to take home the **CHAMPIONSHIP**. The day started with victories over McClure North 84-0, Oakville 84-0 and Lindbergh 58-18 putting the team in the GOLD Division where they dominated the competition. In the semifinals they defeated conference foe Belleville East 66-7 and then Northwest 61-15 in the finals to bring home the **CHAMPIONSHIP**.

This season we entered the team in two varsity level tournaments. First, we competed in the Mt. Olive Tournament again this season placing in the top four at almost every weight class. We were extremely proud of the team and the way they competed throughout the tournament. This season we were able to bring home our first varsity team **CHAMPIONSHIP** competing as a JV team. Good stuff!!

The other varsity tournament we attended was the Quincy Notre Dame Invitational. What another great opportunity for the team to compete at the varsity level. Same amount of teams as Mt. Olive but a few better 1A/2A caliber teams with a couple of very solid kids in each weight class. Our boys came to wrestle once again and finished in 3rd Place as a team. The gym was rocking as we were knocking off higher seeds left and right. The boys earned a lot of respect that day especially from their coaches and parents that were able to watch them.

The JV team capped off a perfect dual meet season winning their next seven duals including the SWC JV Dual Tournament. The team won the conference tournament with wins over Belleville East (51-8), O'Fallon (57-13) and Collinsville (58-12). Another strong performance by the team with a lot of freshman filling voids for regular starters that were competing at the Quincy Invitational the same day. Depth is a great thing and we showed it on this weekend as every member of the program was competing somewhere and winning.

I would like to thank the parents of all the wrestlers for supporting their sons this season, without your support it would be very difficult to be the program we are today. I appreciate the time you allow us to spend with your sons and helping you mold them into great young men of character on and off the mat.

I would also like to thank the senior wrestlers/parents and managers for their hard work, dedication and passion you have shown for the program over the years. 
