Varsity Overview

Although the 2004-05 Tiger Wrestling team fell short of winning the Regional Championship by a few points, ending their quest of a dual team state finish, I feel there was a great deal accomplished this season. Their efforts gained them an impressive 19-3 record during a year when the Tiger Wrestling schedule has *never* been tougher. This year's team finished higher in each of its 4 tournaments, reaching beyond all past team accomplishments. After a convincing championship at the Mascoutah Invite, the Tigers placed 3rd at Granite City, 2nd at Mahomet Seymour, and 1st at Morton. All of these are *team bests* for Edwardsville High School. Senior leadership was once again outstanding this season, with Nick Mueller and Kyle Stumpf leading the way. The Tigers showed great depth once again this season after losing a few wrestlers to injury. This year's squad never gave up or looked backwards, and kept working hard to accomplish what they did. This year's squad will go down as one of EHS's best squads and all who were part should be proud of what they have accomplished.

I ask all of the Senior wrestlers and stat girls to reflect on not what could have been, but on what *Edwardsville Wrestling* has meant and done for you. Success is not always measured on what you have accomplished, but also the *Journey* you have gone through. I hope that being a part of Tiger Wrestling has taught you life lessons and brought unforgettable memories for you and your families. Although your wrestling career may be over, you will never forget it – *it is part of you*. Once a Tiger Wrestler – always a Tiger Wrestler. I am very proud of what many of you have become.

This year's squad had a very large group of underclassmen. After the unfortunate loss of Nick Mueller to injury, the Tigers wrestled with mostly 1 Senior in the Varsity line-up. This bodes well for next season, if we continue to get better. Five State qualifiers (Adam Mestemacher, A.J. Ciccarelli, Bryson Jackstadt, Morris Thomas, and Chris Flaughter) will be returning to next years squad, along with many sectional qualifiers and returning letterman. With the success of the Tiger J.V. and Freshmen squads, next year is shaping up to very competitive in the Tiger Wrestling room. For the large group of returning Juniors, this is your last chance for a championship team – *don't wait!!* Being a Championship team starts now. Your off – season training will determine how far next years team will go. I feel the sky is the limit. Parents, if your son is not working out in the off – season, then he is *not* doing what he should be!!!

Edwardsville Wrestling is a unique program that involves wrestling at all levels, and is a group effort among H.S. coaches, J.H. coaches, IKWF coaches, parents, Booster Club members, and wrestlers. As I have mentioned before, the strength of our program is everybody working together as a whole. I would like to thank everybody involved for making this program what it is today – one that I am very proud of.

I would personally like to thank my coaches (Matarelli, Heinz, and Bevis) for another job well done. Our program would not reach the levels it has without your abilities and guidance. Thank you.

Junior Varsity Wrestling

This years Junior Varsity team showed why Edwardsville is considered one of the premier programs in the state of Illinois. Not many teams in the state can put together such a competitive dual team with a majority of the starters' underclassmen. Many of the young wrestlers that competed for us were freshman and sophomores that have minimal experience in the sport. What they did have was characteristics that are not the easiest for one to coach. Hardworking, competitive, and coach-ability are a few of the characteristics that really stood out with this group of young men throughout the season. These attributes allowed them to compete at a very high level against the areas best teams and be rewarded with a 14-3 dual meet record.

The team performed well at a number of tournaments: placing 1st at the always competitive Lafayette tournament, and 2nd at the Chatham Glenwood tournament. The team also competed at the Collinsville frosh/soph tournament where many of our wrestlers finished very high. Team points were not taken at this tournament. The highlight of the season came at the end of the year when the team achieved their goal of winning the first ever SWC Junior Varsity Dual Team Championship. This was a goal the team had disgusted early in December and decided then to prepare themselves to be wrestling their best at the end of the season. The team not only won their pool but outscored their opponents 218-18 and had more wrestlers (8) in the individual championship match than any other school.

The hard work and dedication of the wrestlers, parents, EWC coaches/boosters, and middle school coaches has really made an impact on what we have been able to accomplish at the high school level. I am blessed to have such great parents, student/athletes, and coaches to work with on a daily basis that all strive to make Edwardsville Wrestling the best. Over the past six years I have learned to love and appreciate the sport of wrestling more than ever. Guys like Mike Freitag, Mark Mestemacher, John Davis, and Jon Wagner have all worked diligently over the years to make Edwardsville wrestling what it is today, a program that prides itself on hard work and discipline. We sometimes refer to this way of coaching and wrestling as "**Tiger Style**".

I would like to remind our wrestlers and parents as we reflect on this season and how much we have accomplished in four short months, that the hard work, sweat, and discipline you have put yourself through has already made you a better son, friend, and person in the eyes of your coaching staff. I wish each member of the 2004-2005 Edwardsville Wrestling team a great off season and look forward to working with you again in the near future.
