
OES Model ISC9000 – Controller Operational Instructions

BEFORE THE GAME



POWER OFF/ON - The Controller is always ON - DO NOT UNPLUG! To REBOOT the controller, press and hold "OFF" until the message below appears.

Press any key to start the "Power On Sequence"



POWER ON SEQUENCE FOR GAME MODE

These first 2 messages will appear for a few seconds each; no action required





hows program revision and date Shows controller operation mode.

Once this message appears, press ENTER



Press **ENTER** to resume **SAVED** game; Press **CLEAR** to load **NEW** game



GAME MODE



GAME TIME

Set Game Time (Period Time)

All timers must be stopped, including the remote

- 1. Press **GAME TIME** button
- 2. Enter minutes on numeric keypad, press ENTER, ENTER, ENTER



Note: During the game, use EITHER the Controller Panel OR Remote to stop and start the clock - (i.e. the system cannot start with one and stop with the other)



Set Period

- 1. Press PERIOD
- 2. Enter value on numeric keypad, press ENTER



Enter Score

- 1. Press HOME SCORE+1 or GUEST SCORE+1 to advance by 1
- 2. To enter a specific value, press HOME SCORE or GUEST SCORE, enter value on numeric keypad, press ENTER



Enter Penalty (clock must be stopped)

1. Press HOME PEN or GUEST PEN (goes to 1st spot, press button again to move to next spot)



- 2. Enter player #, press ENTER
- 3. Enter penalty minutes, press ENTER



Clear Penalty



1. Press HOME PEN or GUEST PEN (goes to 1st spot, keep pressing same button to move through penalties until your cursor is on desired penalty)



2. Press CLEAR button

AFTER THE GAME

POWER OFF/ON - Press and hold "OFF" until "Controller Function Off" message appears. Scoreboard will go dark for 20 seconds and then Time of Day (TOD) will be displayed. If the correct time does NOT appear, go to "Set Time of Day" steps. Revised 6-3-21

OTHER COMMANDS


Set Time of Day (only do this if the TOD is not correct)

1. Hold SETUP button until it prompts you for a password (hold for a few seconds) – enter the password "5833" on numeric keypad, press






2. Select option 3 TOD, Time of Day



3. Select option 4 to set the TOD



- 4. Use the keypad to:
 - i) Set hour, press ENTER, set minutes, press ENTER
 - ii) Press the CLEAR button to toggle between AM and PM, press ENTER
 - iii) Press the CLEAR button to scroll through days of the week, press ENTER
 - iv) Use the keypad to enter the day, month and year, pressing ENTER

after each field



IT MAY TAKE UP TO 20 seconds for the TOD to appear on the SCOREBOARD

If you made a mistake, there is no backspace to correct it – press Enter to go through the entire menu and then start over with the SETUP button.

OTHER COMMANDS – continued

Set Intermission/Break/Time-Out Timer

This timer can be used for intermissions, time outs, and any kind of break timer. Any other timers, like penalty and shot clock, do not operate while using this break timer.

- 1. All timers must be stopped.
- 2. Press INT MODE.





- 3. The last set time will appear.
- 4. If this is okay, press ENTER, ENTER
- 5. If new time is desired, enter Minutes value on Numeric keypad.
- 6. Press ENTER.
- 7. Enter Seconds value on numeric keypad.
- 8. Press ENTER

Use game time RUN and STOP buttons to count down INT MODE timer.

When the timer reaches zero, the horn will sound.

While in INT MODE, press INT MODE to exit back to regular game mode.
