Please read hand out. Don't expect to sign but expect to know. It's also on the EHS website on our Softball page.


- Treat our opponents & umpires with respect. Can't play & have fun without them.

Registration:

- Complete online registration. Registration is open now via MyPaymentsPlus. <u>Please register as soon as</u> <u>possible.</u> It is a big help to us to know numbers. (You can not participate until registered.)
- Ensure you have a valid physical on file with activities office. Physicals are good for <u>3 years</u>. (No physical on file, you can not participate until you do)

Uniform:

- This is why we are here so early before the season. The jerseys are sublimated and take about 8 weeks to receive.
- We are in a new two-year rotation for our uniform.
- Still same process, you order and keep it all, Boosters are just buying jerseys up front.
- Jersey try-ons, Friday February 5th at EHS, conference room "A". Returning players 4:30-5:15, new players 5:15 to 6:00. Players only, no parents in the school please. Checks made out to Eagan Softball Boosters \$55.00.
- DETERMINE SIZE AND AVAILABLE NUMBER FOR UNIFORM AND PAY FOR.
- ALL PLAYERS NEED TO ORDER/HAVE WHITE PANTS, WHITE SOCKS, ROYAL BLUE BELT, & MATTE, ROYAL BLUE HELMET.
- If you are going to wear a long sleeve shirt under your uniform it will need to be <u>white</u>. It's a MSHSL league rule, all players must wear the same color and we chose white.
- Game Day attire Eagan or Generic, no other team/club apparel.

Spirit wear:

- All spirit wear items are optional.

Season Outline/Info

If you are late to or miss practices/games, it will affect your playing time. You will not be penalized for missing if it's due to schoolwork or illness. Please communicate with your coaches.

- Season/try-outs starts Monday March 29th.
- We will be in the EHS gyms during the first week, but all players will need to bring clothes/cleats to practice outside everyday. Anytime weather permits, we will go outdoors!
- Practice times will vary when indoors. Typically, from 4:00/4:30 to 6:30 or 6:30/7:00 to 8:30/9:00. We rotate with Baseball and Lacrosse.
- Try outs will be that first week. If any cuts, those players will be notified during practice on Friday April 2nd. They will know a half hour before practice ends. Teams will also be announced on this day.
- Second week will start individual team practices.
- Games start the third week with first game day being Tuesday, April 13th.

- Once we are outside, each team's coach will set the practice schedule.
- Weather updates for games and practices will be on the front page of our EHS softball web page. An email blast will also be sent out.
- Spring cleanup day TBD All players will participate. We may need some parent volunteers.
- Games start the week of April 12th. (17 game conference schedule & 3 game tournament on a Saturday)

- We only bus to the away games. *All players will need rides home from away games*.
- 7th & 8th graders may need to get out early for away games, depending on opponent.
