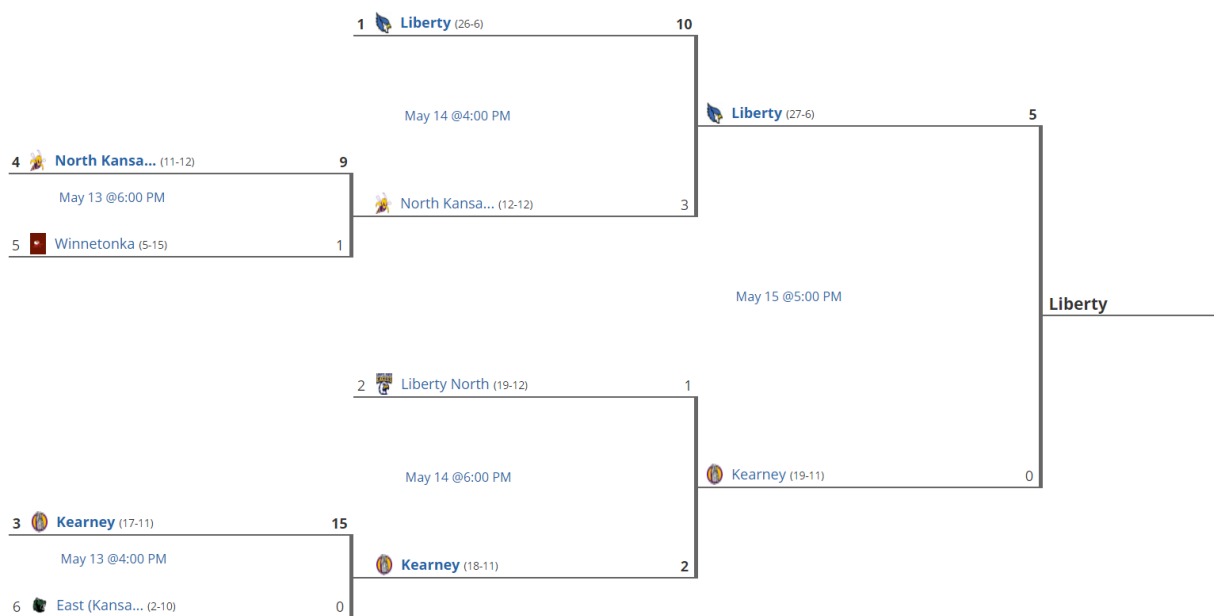

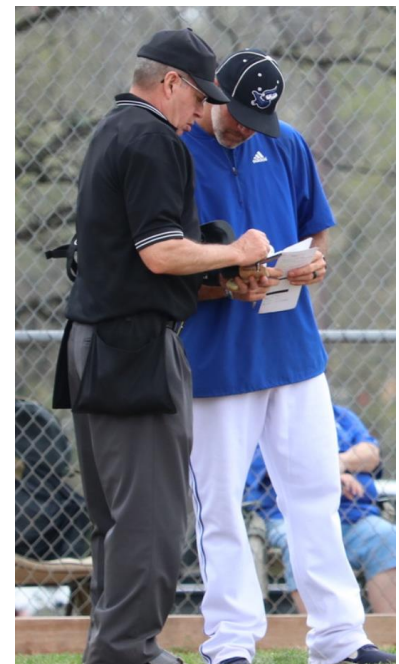

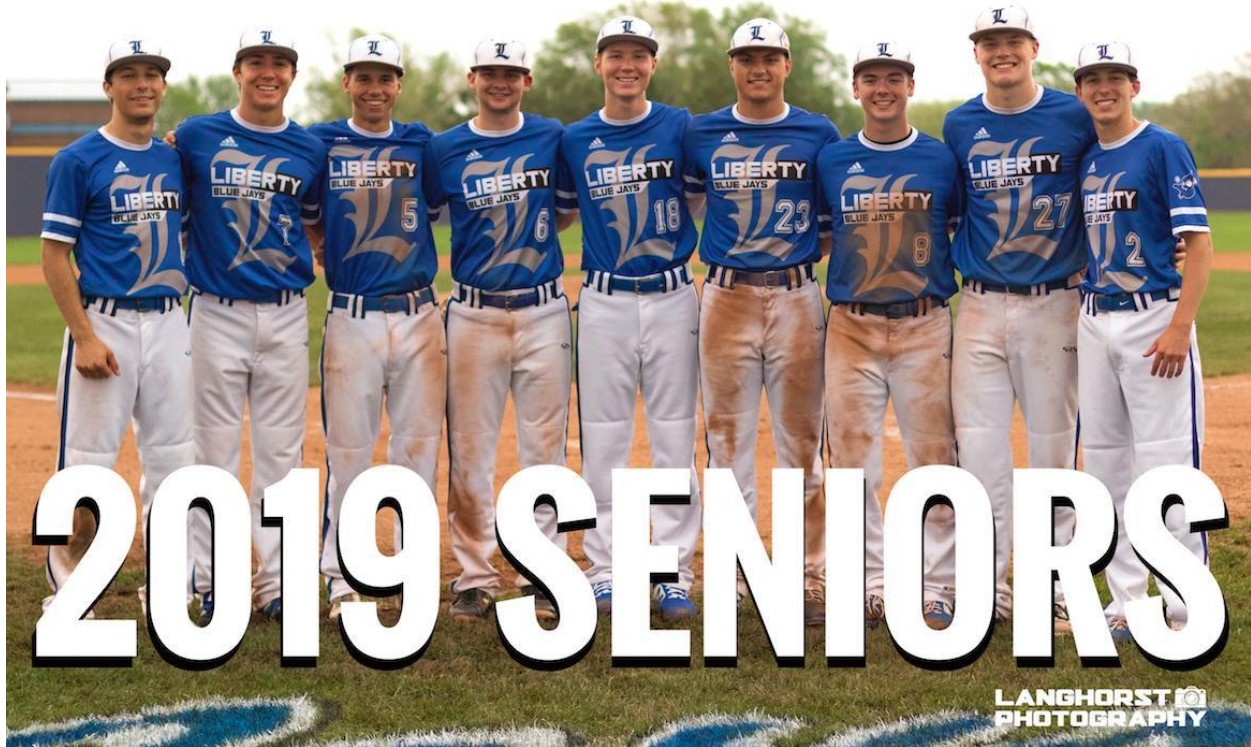

"But, we knew we needed to score a lot more than one run to win that game." The Falcons plated a run in the fourth to tie the game and sealed the deal in the fifth with a pair of runs to go up 3-1. Liberty scored one run on three hits and an error. Staley scored three runs on five hits with two errors.

Braxton Bragg took the loss on the mound for the home squad. The senior went 5 2/3 innings in his final high school game. The University of Nebraska commit allowed five hits, four walks, three runs (two earned) and fanned eight on 104 pitches. Staley senior Carter Rustad went the distance for the Falcons on 89 pitches. He scattered three hits and allowed four walks and an earned run. He too fanned eight.

"You are looking at a battle, and it was," Kirk Bragg said on pitchers Rustad and Braxton Bragg facing off. "I knew it was going to be and just wish it was played maybe a little closer to the final four than sectionals but that is just the way Missouri's system is set up." This was the second time Liberty had faced Rustad this season. "This time around, we were more familiar with what he was giving us," Kirk Bragg said. "Our approach improved. ...I felt like we were a little more prepared for him and made some better adjustments but once again, we just did not get the big hit and could not get anybody to square one up with guys in scoring position." Four of Liberty's six losses this year came by two runs or less.

With the win, Staley swept the season series 2-0 after defeating Liberty 4-3 in the regular season in 11 innings. With the loss, Liberty finishes the season 28-7.

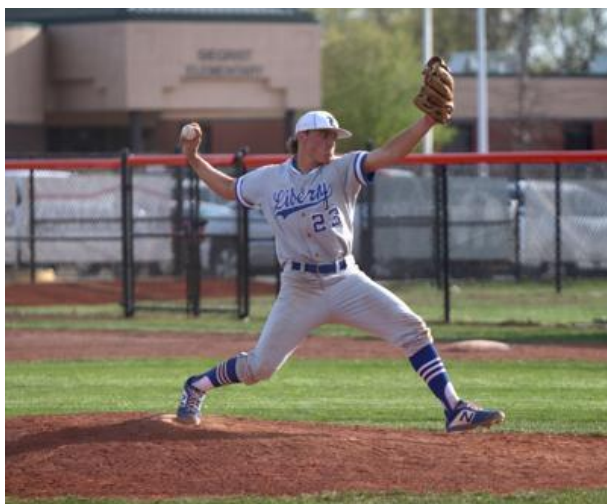
Liberty baseball edges out Liberty North

Liberty baseball secures back-to-back district titles



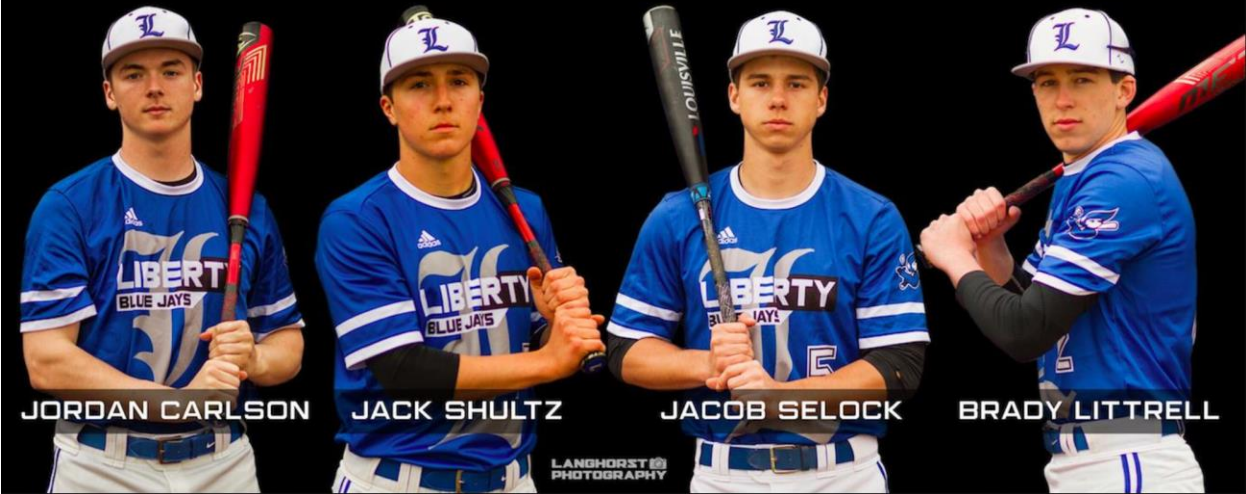

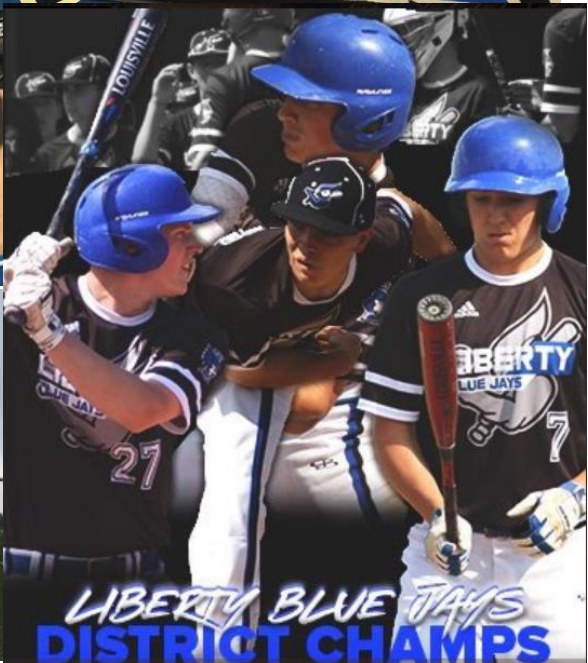
