HOC Department Updates:

- Boys High School Tryouts are happening next week.
- Girls High School Tryouts are complete and teams are formed.
- Teams/ABC There was more discussion regarding the small teams for the 12Us and the things that can be done in the future to prevent this from happening again. Also discussed was having better communication with parents on the front end with a parent meeting, as well as how each year we seem to have some of the same issues on the girls side and how we can work to overcome these in the future.

- Player Development Adam and Keith presented a plan that includes hiring Austin Youngmark two days a week for the season to work with players in the weight room. The plan would also include a full makeover of the weight room and improvements to the Green Room. Approximate expenses would be \$7,200 for Austin's fee, \$6,000 for Green Room equipment (bands, balls, etc.) and \$27,800 for weight room equipment (power blocks, kettle bells, squat racks, etc.)
 - o A motion was made to approve \$41,000 for the player development request including hiring Austin Youngmark and weight room equipment.
 - Mike 1st, Jake 2nd. Discussion around doing this upgrade in phases instead of one large request. It was also discussed that the Player Development and HOC look to spread out the focus on all the levels, not just the Bantams/15s. Motion passed (9-1, Maria).
 - JP said the old weight room equipment that was moved to the back hall needs to be gone by 11/9. Ryan Otto is going to figure out how to get these items gone before the girls game.
