Overview – 7U to 14U

The Colleyville Baseball Association sanctions several select, skill based 7U to 14U AA, AAA, Majors and High School youth baseball programs. League play for the select programs are played in the Texas Elite Baseball Association (TEBA).

This is a serious commitment of time, energy, and money for the selected players/parents. Select baseball is NOT an equal play program, however, our coaches' goals are to develop all players and will play the kids accordingly. It is a place for those who choose to play a higher level of baseball. Players are "selected" by the team coach based on skill and ability. Team coaches for the select programs are appointed by the Colleyville Baseball Association Board of Directors (the "Board") and are re-evaluated every season.

Overview - Select High School Baseball

CBA offers UHS, a league for players in high school, and have at least 3-5 years' prior experience. The team is for boys with varying baseball skills who desire additional repetitions and want to play additional games, practices, and tournaments. These high school-aged select teams can both integrate with players' obligations to their High School team, and it can serve as an opportunity for those who want to continue playing beyond 14U but do not play with their High School team. There is 1 practice per week at Colleyville City Park, and the teams play doubleheaders on Saturday or Sunday in Colleyville or a local city within 30 miles.

Team Formation

- The CBA will host Select tryouts before each season.
- Coaches may also conduct private tryouts when players are unable to attend the CBA sanctioned tryout.
- Coaches form their roster by making offers to players they are interested in. It is ultimately the family's decision if they want to accept the offer or not.
- Coaches should adhere to roster rules for the level they are registering for (AA, AAA, Majors). See tournament rules and local association rules for guidance. Any disqualification for not following the rules is the sole responsibility of the head coach.
- CBA Select teams must include at least 7 players who are either residents of GCISD or have played the previous 2 seasons with the CBA. Any exceptions must be approved by the President, Vice President, and Select Commissioner
- CBA Select head coaches may add a maximum of 4 guest players to the roster for a game or tournament.
- When utilizing guest players, CBA Select head coaches are encouraged to pick up guest players that are already registered with another CBA Select team. If a guest player is from outside of the CBA, such player is required to register with the CBA and pay a fee of \$35. This is for insurance purposes.

Team Name

- New Select teams will either be "Panthers" or "Stars"
- Exempt Teams - teams formed prior to Spring 22 season are exempt from adopting the new CBA team names.



Uniforms

- Families are responsible for the purchase of all items needed (jerseys, hats, pants, belt, socks, etc.).
- Coach will only use CBA approved uniform supplier for jerseys and hats
- Team will only use CBA approved uniform designs
- Standard color themes are:
 - o Panthers = Red, White & Black
 - o Stars = Red, White & Navy
- New jersey and hat variations can be requested by the coach but require approval from the Board. Requests should be submitted to the Select Commissioner, who will present them to the Board for approval. Once approved, the new variation will be made available to all other Select teams.
- Exempt Teams can continue to use legacy uniform supplier.

Regular Season (TEBA)

- Each team will play a regular season schedule of 8, 10 or 12 games (4, 5 or 6 doubleheaders)
 - o Spring season runs from late March through early May
 - o Fall season runs from late August to late October
- Barring field availability issues, half of the doubleheaders will be played at Home (Colleyville City Park) and half of the doubleheaders will be played Away.
- Other associations that participate in TEBA include Southlake, Grapevine, Keller, Coppell, Flower Mound, Highland Village, Trophy Club and Prosper (varies by age group).
- Each coach must register their team with TEBA when instructed by the CBA scheduler and Select Commissioner. There is no additional cost. The purpose is to get all relevant team information in the hands of the TEBA Commissioner and schedulers so season schedule can be created.
- There is a TEBA meeting that takes place before each season that the Select Commissioner will attend. Select Commissioner will circulate all relevant information from those meetings to the coaches.
- CBA Select teams are required to play TEBA league games. Majors teams are eligible to opt out of TEBA league play once they reach age 12U.

Rules

- The set of rules for the hosting association will govern TEBA games.
- The set of rules for each tournament organization will govern each tournament they host

Tournaments

- Tournaments will be scheduled around your TEBA schedule. Coaches are given the opportunity to request blackout dates when registering for TEBA. Prior to the TEBA schedule release each season, CBA coaches can only pay to enter tournaments that fall on the same weekends as their requested TEBA blackout weekends. Coaches are encouraged to register for other possible tournaments, but do not pay for them until the official TEBA schedule is released.
