### Arrival & Departure Procedures - Centre Wellington

We want to avoid congestion of participants as well as limiting cross contamination. Players will be required to complete the Wellness Pre-Participation Screening Form before entering the field. It is encouraged that they keep their equipment in the car, and only take their required equipment with them onto the field. To avoid exceeding the government mandated maximum persons in an outdoor gathering, please ensure that you arrive only approximately 15 minutes prior to the start of your session.





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### **Arrival & Departure Procedures Inclement Weather Policy**

- Arrival to Staging
  - a. Parents/guardians dropping their participant off in the north-east parking lot off of Albert St W.
  - b. Participants will proceed to registration with their respective divisional Safety/Hygiene manager to perform the Wellness Pre-Participation Screening Form.
  - c. The Safety/Hygiene manager will direct the participant along the running track to their corresponding staging area.
- Staging to Training
  - a. Coaches will greet players and escort them to the training area players will be provided with a physically distanced training area at the facility.
- Training to Departure
  - a. After the participants' training has completed, participants will be directed along the running track to the pickup area by the north-west parking lot. Participants will wait in a physically distanced line for their parent/guardian to pick them up promptly after training has completed.
- Parent / Guardian Parking and Viewing
  - a. In order to maintain the government mandated limit of 100 participants in outdoor events, we request that only one parent/guardian attends their players training session.
  - b. Parking is available on both sides of Albert St W, in both the north-east and north-west parking lots, as well as along the baseball diamonds on the north-east side of St David St S (not pictured).
  - c. Parents may view games along the end lines of the respective fields, but must remain physically distanced.
  - d. Parents viewing from the endline should be paying attention at all times to avoid injury from flying balls.

### **Inclement Weather Policy**

Playing outside, we are bound to encounter all sorts of types of weather, we need to be prepared in-case adjustments need to be made to our programs.



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### **Arrival & Departure Procedures Inclement Weather Policy**

Inclement weather: is weather that is harsh, wet and cold. Often this type of weather is accompanied by high winds. Keeping in mind that we are all playing locally, the call to cancel games for the day will be made up to game time. However, it is important to watch our website (<https://www.cwmla.com/>) and social media feeds for updates if inclement weather has been forecasted (i.e. severe thunderstorms).

Thunderstorms: in the event that games are played in the rain, and lightning is sighted:

- If games are in their first half, players will return to their cars for a 30 minute break, games will resume in the second half if no lightning is sighted during their 30 minute break. If lightning is sighted again, the 30 minute break restarts. If the game is delayed for more than 40 minutes, the game is called, and the score at that point in time stands.
- If games are in the second half, the game is called, and the score at that point in time stands.
