

***NYSA COVID FAQ:**

Q:What happens if a player on my child's team has tested positive for covid?

A: The child that has tested positive they will need to quarantine per the [CDC Guidelines](#).

Q: Does my child or coach need to wear a mask if unvaccinated?

A: It is the recommendation that all unvaccinated individuals continue to wear masks.

Q: Does my child or coach need to quarantine if they were exposed to Covid-19?

A: You are welcome to quarantine your child to ensure their safety. However, the state requires that only non-vaccinated individuals quarantine until they receive a negative test result. All vaccinated individuals are not required to quarantine.

Q: Does my child need to be quarantined if they had a positive test result?

A: Yes. Your child must quarantine per the [CDC Guidelines](#).

Q:Do I need to wear a mask at my child's game?

A: Yes. NYSA has a mask mandate in place to support our field contracts with cities and school districts. Please wear a mask at all times.

Q: What do we do if our opponent refuses to wear masks?

A: Please have your coach or your team manager document the issue. Our coaches, team managers and staff will work to escalate the issue with the appropriate league. Please do not try to enforce this mandate on your own.

Q: What do I do if my child has been exposed at their school through a batch test?

A: Each school district maintains their own set of protocols. You will need to follow your school district's policy.
