2023 SPRING SEASON FEES

Park City Baseball has a long-term community commitment to the sport. PCB utilizes the volunteer time and talent to provide its services. PCB uses a combination of fundraising, fees and corporate underwriting to financially operate. The fees listed below include Basin Recreation Fieldhouse and City field fees, RMSB league fees and tournament registration. Fees DO NOT include uniforms.

Fees for all Spring 2023 teams will be \$500 per player.
12u will have additional fees for Cooperstown Dreams Park.

PLEASE READ CAREFULLY: There will be additional fees, which are NOT included in the spring season fees. These will include but are not limited to uniform items that are not included in the mandatory items (pants, helmets, bats, bags, etc), travel costs (hotels, food, gas), and additional tournaments that a team might add.

****You will receive an email from Sports Engine with an invoice. *The invoice will be sent to the primary email used during registration.* All fees need to be paid by March 25, 2023.**



PRACTICES

Practices are rotated between teams on Tuesdays, Fridays and Saturdays starting March 3rd. Schedules will be communicated to teams and added to Game Changer by team managers. Locations are Basin Rec Field House and Park City Baseball Academy until teams can get outside on various fields around Park City.

UNIFORM INFORMATION SHEET

UNIFORMS: SHOP OPENS MONDAY, FEBRUARY 27th and CLOSES THURSDAY, MARCH 2nd

Ordered online through Protime Sports with sizing information available on the uniform website. All uniforms are ordered & paid for individually but distributed through the league once Spring 2023 fees have been paid by players.

MANDATORY UNIFORM ITEMS INCLUDE:

One Jersey (8-9u) or Two Jerseys (10-14u) | Practice Shirt | Sweatshirt | Belt | Socks

YOU WILL NEED TO PURCHASE ON YOUR OWN (but also available in the team shop):

Grey Pants (no stripes) | extra uniform items | Bags

Batting helmets and gloves will be need to be purchased on your own
as many items normally available are affected by the supply chain demand issue.

CHOOSE BULK SHIPPING for \$2 as the shipping option.

Park City Baseball is purchasing hats for all players & will be distributed during practices in March..

Uniform packages will be approximately \$100-150 per player, depending on whether your player wears youth or adult sizes and depending on age level of the team. Additional items will also be available for purchase like pants and extra socks or belts.

The website for purchasing uniform items & a link to choose your player's jersey number will be sent to the primary email address on file.

Items will be shipped to the league and distributed through managers and/or coaches.

PLEASE NOTE: Once the Protime Shop opens to Park City Baseball, you will have a short window to order the required uniform items. THE UNIFORM SHOP WILL CLOSE ON THURSDAY, MARCH 2nd.

If you miss the deadline your player will NOT have a uniform for the season.

- ☐ **Attend Mandatory Parent Meeting on Monday, Feb 27th at 6:30 pm.** Via zoom or watch recorded zoom session.
- ☐ **Order Uniforms Online via the Uniform Shop** on your own. Dates February 27th-March 2nd, 2023. Uniforms will be distributed via the league through practices in Mid to Late March once fees have been confirmed and paid.
