Subject: Canada Soccer Taking Expressions of Interest for IDEA Conference Panel

Canada Soccer's Inclusion, Diversity, Equity, and Accessibility (IDEA) Conference is being planned, and in preparation for the multi-day virtual event, Canada Soccer is taking expressions of interest for panel discussions from community soccer leaders.

Between now and October 25, Canada Soccer wants to hear from Club leaders who have "implemented a strategy, program, or process that has increased opportunity, access, and inclusivity in [their Club]," as described in a statement from the governing body.

The main objective of the IDEA Conference is to amplify the work being done in the spaces of inclusion, diversity, equity, and accessibility, showcasing real-life success stories from soccer organizations that uphold and promote these values. Topics of discussion at the IDEA virtual Conference will include women and girls in soccer, LGBTQ+ inclusion, all-abilities soccer, anti-racism, and New to Canada participants in soccer.
