

## Here's how it works!

The Dave Krache Foundation is a 501(c)3 non-profit whose aim is to assist with financial fees related to metro Atlanta kids' sports' leagues and teams. We have helped kids participate in softball, baseball, football, basketball, lacrosse, martial arts, track, cycling, and more. The league/team does not necessarily have to be associated with the school.



Here's how it works:

Anyone can initiate the request. Whether it's someone who needs the help, or someone who knows a family in need, anyone can take Step 1:

### **Step 1:**

The person initiating the request gets a copy of our Request for Financial Assistance Form.

### **Step 2:**

The parent or guardian of the child playing the sport from the family that needs the financial assistance fills out pages 1 and 2. **One packet should be completed for each child.**

### **Step 3:**

At this point, pages 1-2 of the 4 in total have been completed. The parent/guardian emails the .pdf to the person who is "vouching" for them. This could be a teacher, counselor, social worker, pastor, or coach. This person should not be related to them.

### **Step 4:**

That teacher/coach completes pages 3 and 4. After all fields are completed on all pages, the teacher/coach emails it to: [help@davekrache.com](mailto:help@davekrache.com)

**If fields are left blank on the application**, the Board will not review the request.

**If this is a repeat request**, the Board may request additional information after the initial application is submitted.

**There must be family buy-in / contribution on page 2.** Only under extremely dire circumstances can the DKF help with 100% of the season fees. The minimum amount being requested may not equal the total cost of registration for the season.

**All correspondence should be done via email with the teacher/coach.** The Foundation makes payments directly to the leagues/parks/teams - no individual or private business may receive payment from us.

**Please ensure that the address supplied on page 4 is correct.** A DKF representative will notify you if the request has been granted and to expect 5-7 business days for a check to arrive. **If there is a problem with the address, the DKF is unable to redirect funds until the money is back via returned check. This may affect the child's ability to play!**

The Dave Krache Foundation communicates with the league/park/team or teacher/counselor/social worker only. If you are a parent and have a question about the status of your request, please see the individual who helped you complete and submit the form.

**Required as of January 1, 2019:** A League/Team Self-Assessment Form. Only one per year, per organization is required. If one is not on file at the time of a Financial Request being submitted, an Assessment must be completed prior to Request Review.
