MATCHUP WITH MADISON

LAST GAME - CHICAGO: The Chicago Steel defeated the Cedar Rapids RoughRiders 5-2 on Friday night at Fox Valley Ice Arena. It was the first regulation win on home ice for Chicago since Dec. 30th, a 9-3 victory over the Madison Capitols. Chicago was outshot 33-29 in the win. The Steel went 0-for-3 (0.0%) on the power play. Chicago is now 13-6-2-1 on home ice this season. Jack Harvey registered a career-best four point game with two goals and two helpers while Nick Moldenhauer added a pair of goals in the win. Netminder Christian Manz turned away 31 shots to improve his record to 9-3-0-1 between the Steel pipes in his rookie season. Andon **Cerbone** scored his eighth goal of the year in the victory.

LAST GAME - MADISON: The Madison Capitols fell 3-1 against the Dubuque Fighting Saints on March 11 at Mystique Community Ice Center in Iowa. Despite scoring the first goal of the game, the Capitols surrendered three unanswered tallies to Dubuque. The Capitols held a 42-15 advantage in shots on goal in the loss and couldn't reach the back of the net on two power play opportunities. Madison's penalty kill unit went 2-for-2 (100%) on the night. Kyle Kukkonen tallied the lone goal for the Capitols while **Simon Latkoczy** made 12 saves in net.

AGAINST THE CAPITOLS: The Steel are 29-9-3-0 in all-time regular season matchups with Madison, including a 15-4-1-0 advantage as the home team. Through six meetings during the 2021-2022 campaign, the Steel have a 3-2-1-0 record against the Eastern Conference foes with four scheduled contests remaining.

DELANEY DELIVERS: Over his last four games, Steel rookie forward **Chris Delaney** has reached the scoresheet in three outings with four helpers in those contests. All seven of the UMass-Amherst commit's assists have come since the start of the new year, giving **Delaney** seven points (7A) over his last 17 appearances for Chicago.

THE PUCK STOPS HERE: Chicago has allowed three or fewer goals in seven of their last 10 contests with a 6-2-1-1 mark over that stretch. Netminders Gibson Homer and Christian Manz have factored in for a 3.28 goals-against average as a team, good for seventh among USHL teams this season.

ALL CAPS: Defenseman **Luke Mittelstadt** is the only blueliner in the USHL thus far through the 2021-2022 campaign to lead his team in points with 43 (16G, 27A) through 49 games this season. The Eden Prairie, Minn., native has been held to three helpers over six appearances against the Steel this season. Former Chicago Steel forward Quinn Finley brings a three-game point streak (1G, 2A) into Saturday night's showdown. Finley was a part of the 2021 Clark Cup Championship club in Chicago.




