Competitions

Trap and Skeet events start at 6pm sharp. Participants need to arrive and be ready to participate by 5:45pm. A team meeting will take place at 5:45pm which will include line assignments. Visit our website for Fall season competition dates. Trap will be on Wednesday nights and Skeet is on Thursday nights.

Range Safety Officers

We are looking for adults that would like to volunteer to be a "range safety officer". As a range safety officer you will be assigned to a specific field and will monitor the actions of the participants looking for potential safety issues. Metro (Make-Up Rounds)

A policy change has been made. If a participant misses a competition night those unused rounds will not be reimbursed

Line Assignments

During competitive weeks line assignments will be based off season averages. This allows participants to compete with participants with similar scores.

Weather Policy

Safety is our #1 priority. Events may be cancelled due to weather. If you have not received a cancellation email prior to our start time arrive at the field at the usual time. We will compete in the rain or snow. Metro Gun Club determines if a cancellation is due to weather (lightning).

Absent

If you will not be able to make it to a Trap or Skeet event you must notify head coach John Hanselman via his cell phone (612-790-0190) in advance. Knowing who will miss an event is important as the coaches set the lines for the night. Unexcused absences will affect your season scoring.

High School Lettering

Athletes can receive a letter through the high school in trap in the Spring season. Please visit our website regarding lettering requirements (under the "About" tab). Unexcused absences will go against your season scoring and lettering requirements.

Sportsmanship

Participants and families are asked to follow common sportsmanship guidelines. This would include respecting Metro (i.e. speeding in the parking lot), respecting the scores of other participants and controlling emotions after a good or bad round. Other teams compete at Metro and we all represent the city of Spring Lake Park and the school district at competitions, school and in the community.
