APPAREL

PLAYER PACKS

- Includes game cap, practice cap, practice shorts, and practice shirts (long and short sleeve).
- All players are responsible for supplying their own white game pants with a single thin black piping down the side.

REACHING OUR GOALS

We reach our goals by leveraging fundraising and volunteer activities to support and improve the program. Monies raised help cover the following costs:

- Assistant coaches' salaries
- Equipment (baseballs, catchers gear, pitching machine, L-screens, etc.)
- Field maintenance (turf repair, sod, Ag-Lime, weed and fertilizer management, etc.)
- Dome fees for winter workouts & spring tryouts
- Facility improvements (paint, bullpens, batting cages, field upgrades such as backstop, batters eye, safety netting, etc.)
- Machine maintenance (infield groomer, lawn mowers, pitching machine, tractor maintenance)
- Subsidize cost of Player Packs
- Subsidize out of town baseball trips

Booster Club Fee

- Required for the season for a cost of \$150 due on opening night.
- Fee is tax deductible, as a donation to a non-profit we are a 501(c)(3) (EID 90-0738804).
- The fee goes into the general fund with monies from fundraising to help cover expenses associated with reaching our goals listed above.

SALT & PIZZA FUNDRAISERS



The Water Softener Salt and Heggies Pizza sale is one of our major fundraisers. Our baseball program would not exist without your fundraising efforts!

GUIDELINES

- Sell as many bags of salt and pizzas as possible between Friday, March 22nd and Monday April 15th.
- Each player MUST sell \$250 worth of **PROFIT** (sell roughly 50 items), or buyout the difference.

ORDERING & PICKUP INSTRUCTIONS

- Use Sales Sheets and Order Forms for both salt and pizza sales.
- Customer payment is required at time of order. If possible, we ask that your customers write a check payable to YOU, and you write ONE check payable to "Osseo Baseball Booster."
- Add up all columns and double check totals and payment.
- Turn in order forms and payment on Monday, April 15th to team liaisons, fundraising coordinator or booster club treasurer – additional information will be provided prior to turn in date.
- Do NOT give forms or money to coaches.

WATER SOFTENER SALT

- PICK UP salt orders date is the week of May 13th at Fleet Farm in Brooklyn Park.
- ORDER FORMS will be returned to each player at pick up to confirm orders.
- DELIVER salt and offer to carry the bags into their home and fill their water softener. This "service" is part of the fundraiser and encourages customers to buy again!


HEGGIES PIZZA

- PICKUP date April 29th OSH. We are using the school freezers.
- ORDER FORMS will be returned to each player at pickup to confirm orders and distribute pizzas.

SELLING GUIDELINES

- INTRODUCE yourself and let your customer know you are with Osseo Baseball.
- INFORM them that you are fundraising by selling water softener salt and Heggies pizza.
- SHOW customer the Sales Sheets for types of salt and pizzas.
- EXPLAIN what this fundraiser helps pay for:
 - O Coaches' salaries, equipment and gear
 - o Field improvements and maintenance, and equipment/supplies needed
 - o Equipment (batting cage netting, hitting screens, baseballs, catcher's gear, etc.)
 - Remind customers of the benefits of purchasing from Osseo Baseball
 - o Salt delivered directly to their home and water softener
 - Support of local youth baseball programs
