Primary Duties

- Responsible for the on- and off-ice developmental activities of all Lakeville Hockey Association “South” traveling players.
- Works as an integral member of the Hockey Development Committee (HDC) to determine the objectives and needs for player development.
- Proposes resources and programs to the Hockey Development Committee and LHA Board of Directors fulfill the development needs of these players.
- Works as a members of the HDC to direct the player evaluation process, including selection of evaluators and criteria for scoring
- Makes recommendations to the South Association Head Coach on potential team coaching staff.
- Researches, designs, updates, and recommends training development program(s) working within a pre-approved budget.
- Identifies online and digital developmental resources and works with the Communications Director to share with the teams.
- Conducts in-season meetings with coaches as needed to share developmental goals and tactics
- Works with all South Head Coaches to develop and implement player or level specific development programs
- Makes recommendations
- Reviews and makes recommendations based on the end of season member survey
- Assists the VP of Operation in the selection of evaluators for traveling team tryouts
- Works as a member of the Hockey Development Committee (HDC) to determine the objectives and needs for coach development and to organize resources and programs to fulfill those needs
- Assists with the tryout process as needed
- Participates in the tryout format design and player evaluation process
- Ensures coach compliance with the LHA Code of Conduct
- Makes recommendations to the Board for disciplinary action for any coach that violates the LHA Code of Conduct

Committee Membership and Meetings

- Hockey Development Committee – 1-2 times per month, required
- Monthly Board Meetings – 2nd Wednesday of each month, required
