1. Addendum - 18U College Selects team

- Our College Prep Division has gained entry in the BLE 18U Showcase tournament in Kamloops May 3-7. Many of the best teams in the country attend this tournament. With changes in Baseball BC pathways to Western and Nationals it is not feasible to send a Provincial Championship team to the US tournament in New Jersey that BCMBA did when not a member of the PSO.
- In talking with CP divisional coaches last year about going back to possible Showcase player weekend, it was thought entering a tournament to promote the division and players was a better opportunity. Thus, I had many conversations with Marty Lehn which led to an entry into the 2023 tournament.
- As part of the CP pre-season meeting the high performance opportunity was presented to coaches and were in support of. Online coach applications were encouraged and as per Chris' notes three coaches applied. Two (2) coaches were presented to the HP Committee for

recommendations and approved. Both agreed once advised of the opportunity. Since then the approved coaches have started internal discussions for coach's player recommendations to come with a maximum roster of eighteen (18) players. Coaches will have final say with support of BCMBA 18U directors for roster. Selects coaches will work with all other divisional teams for recommendations and such to put the best team forward.

 players. Budget is currently being worked on and player fees to be determined to help offset
 costs just like any other HP programmes/teams. Hotel booking has been done for twenty (20)

General Eligibility for All Members

Players must meet the Baseball Canada age requirements for their division. No overage players are permitted for any reason except when provided for female athletes.

All out of catchment players must have been approved by the member (Little League, PBL, Babe Ruth, BC Minor) and be permitted under their own transfer rules.

Teams may not add players who have not been part of their local association or club during the spring season per their member's rules unless modified in this document.

Unless modified in this document, Baseball BC generally follows a member's own rules to determine the eligibility of athletes and teams.

Players are permitted to play in multiple qualifiers provided they are on different weekends. For example, a player who is rostered at 15U AAA during the season, could play in the 18U AAA Tier 1 or 2 qualifier as a pick-up and still be eligible to play in the 15U AAA qualifier.

13U AAA - Little League

An Association may choose to enter a team, consisting of players who reside within their boundaries. A District may choose to enter a team, consisting of any combination of players from within their District's associations.
