TOURNAMENT SCHEDULING INFORMATION:

All ISWA member clubs in good standing are eligible to schedule a tournament. If your club plans on hosting a tournament it is **REQUIRED** that a club official listed on current club charter attend this meeting to confirm a bid for the date(s). **No** tournaments will be sanctioned having not been bid at this meeting. Please come prepared to schedule your tournament at this time with your primary and alternate dates.

HOSTING AN EVENT:

The sanction fee for hosting a tournament is **\$175.00**. This fee includes a USA Wrestling Event Sanction (1 million dollar liability coverage) and posting of your event information on the ISWA web site: www.iswa.com and on the USA Wrestling web site: www.theMat.com. There is no extra charge for hosting one or more open events on the same week-end. Tournaments will be posted on the website upon **receipt** of the following:

1. Sanction Application 2. Payment 3. Flyer information.

Each sanction (club or tournament) must have a 2019/2020 coach or officials USA membership number.

All proceeds derived from an event remain with the host club.

Clubs may view ISWA calendar posted on the ISWA website under “Tournaments” and “Event Schedule” on drop down menu.

All ISWA member clubs are encouraged to attend the Annual Meeting of the corporation. Many issues are discussed and policies set that involve your club wrestlers, such as fees, rules modifications, election of officers, amendments to the by-laws, etc. Each member club shall have one vote. This vote must be cast in person by a duly authorized member of the club. All officers and directors will have one vote. If you are on the ISWA Board of Directors and also represent an ISWA club your vote will be counted once. In no case will any person, who is eligible to vote at any meeting of the corporation, have more than one vote as defined by the articles of incorporation.
