## New Business

- **Presidents Report** (Troy Domine)
  - No new information



- **Treasurer's Report** (Kris Wilke)
  - Kris W. provided 2024-25 proposed budget.
  - Pre golf tournament money in the bank of \$22,000
  - Based on proposed 2024-25 money budgeted compared to upcoming expenses for the next year, we could be in the red by \$4,000.
  - Committee discussed creating a long term savings account for future big purchases that benefit each hockey program. This will be the main focus for our next meeting.
  
- **Golf Tournament Report** (Ron McCabe)
  - Final proceeds show that we raised \$14,000 for this year's tournament.
  - Catered meal was great.
  - Montgomery National hosted the event. There were expectations that they would be more helpful at the conclusion of the tournament as far as collecting scorecards, picking up the proxies from the games on the course, and tallying the final scores to provide a list of winners. Committee in the future will make sure to work more closely with the golf course on what we need and expect from them.
  - One golf cart was damaged during the tournament that had \$750 damage. The responsible parties involved are working with the golf course to resolve the problem and the association is not directly affected by the incident.
  - Committee will review at a future meeting on possibly setting age limits for eligible golfers, or have them accompanied by their parents.
  - Suggestion was made to raise the entry fee from \$110 per golfer to \$125. To be discussed at later meetings.
  - Ron made visits for pricing to Shoreland and LeSueur golf courses for hosting the 2025 event. Based on his findings, the committee made the decision to have the tournament at Shoreland Golf Course on July 7th 2025.
