2025-26 HHA Fees and Obligations

Fundraising Fee

Each **FAMILY** (regardless of the number of skaters) in the Squirt through Varsity level is expected to raise \$400.00 per season through wreath/Candle sales and/or other opportunities presented throughout the season. Sales begin at registration (wreath information is available following the meeting) and normally end in December. Fundraising fees are non-refundable and non-transferable and cannot be "carried over" to the next season. Any skater who drops from the program after having skated with HHA for any portion of the present season will need to pay 1/2 of the fundraiser fee. Any unpaid fees may prohibit a skater from joining HHA in the next or subsequent seasons. Fundraising credits for wreath sales will be calculated as one-half of the total amount sold by each family. For example family sold \$800 in wreathes, they will receive \$400 in fundraising credit.

Volunteer Fee PLEASE READ!!

<u>League Play</u> families (<u>Squirt through Varsity</u>) will be assessed a <u>\$975.00</u> Volunteer Obligation. The amount of credits required has increased slightly – at <u>15 credits</u> (2 of them required in the feed box) – Each <u>credit is worth \$65.00</u>. At your parent meeting at the beginning of the season, a check payable to HHA for \$975.00 is required as a deposit towards your volunteer credits. At the end of the season, your check will be destroyed if you meet your obligation, cashed if you did not earn any of your credits, or, if your credits are partially met, arrangements will be made to swap checks for the difference. This policy is no different than any other volunteer based organizations such as baseball, swim team, etc.

<u>Mite</u> Families will be assessed a \$520 Volunteer Obligation – or 8 credits (2 required in the feedbox). A check will also be required at the beginning of the season for \$520.00 with the same stipulations listed above.

<u>Mini Mite</u> Families will not be required to meet volunteer credits, however it is recommended Mini's shadow 2 DIBS volunteer tasks sometime throughout the season.

IF YOU HAVE SKATERS IN MULTIPLE LEVELS, YOU WILL FOLLOW THE GUIDELINES FOR THE OLDEST SKATER ONLY. (Example: if you have a mite and varsity player – you will only need to meet the \$780 obligation – not both)

Full volunteer credit will be given to persons serving a full term in the following positions: Board member, team coordinator, league scheduler, Team feedbox coordinator (2 weekends. If you "co-coordinate" you will have to split the credits), coaches, zamboni operators, Advertising Coordinator for signage/program. Credits are not given for pre-season preparations and rink cleaning. Credits are not transferable to other families without **prior** approval from the Board for special circumstances (illness in the family, etc.). Persons serving in the following positions: Association feedbox coordinator, fundraising coordinators (i.e. wreath-candles, etc.), equipment room manager will receive full volunteer credits; exemption from family fundraising of \$400; and zero fee for family season pass.

Registration Fee

Each skater is required to become a member of USA Hockey through their online website at: www.usahockey.com. A separate USA Hockey membership fee is paid directly to USA Hockey. Your USA Hockey number is required when registering with the Huron Hockey Association.

HHA fees per skater are as follows:

Mini Mite \$75; Mite \$150; Squirt \$250; PeeWee \$325; Girls U14 \$350; Bantam \$350; JV/Varsity Boys/Girls \$450. First time skaters at any age will receive a 50% discount off the above listed price. Families with multiple skaters will not be charged more than \$900 for HHA registration per season regardless of the number of skaters. Online USA Hockey registration fees, season passes, and Equipment rental fees are not included in this family cap/discount. Families meeting the family cap will have to pay for their registrations up front. A refund will be processed once your registration is paid in full. A minimum of 1/3 of the total registration fee (per family) is due at the time of registration. The second 1/3 is due September 1st. The final 1/3 is due October 1. All returning League Level skaters must be registered by midnight on Thursday, July 31, 2025 to avoid a \$25 Late Fee per skater.

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Season Pass

Each Family of a League Player (PeeWee, Girls 14-U, Bantam, JV/Varsity Boys and Girls) is required to purchase a family Season pass for \$50.00. The family season pass is non-transferable. Family passes allow admission into all levels of *regular* season hockey games at the Bergman Arena. Each member of the players immediate family (parents, siblings) <u>living in the same household as the skater</u>, is entitled to a pass. In a situation where the parents live in separate households (i.e. divorce situations, etc.) a pass will be provided to each parent. Family passes are NOT intended to be used for grandparents, neighbors, visiting relatives, older siblings no longer living at home, etc. These passes are intended for immediate family only. Family pass fees do not apply to the family cap. There is also a season pass available to the lower levels (Mini Mite, Mite, Squirt for \$25).

Equipment Fees/Rental/Jersey Deposit

Equipment rental is available through HHA's equipment room. Full equipment rental fees are as follows: Mini Mite \$50; Mite \$50; Squirt \$75; PeeWee \$100; 14U Girls \$100; Bantam \$150; JV/Varsity Guys and Girls \$250. Goalie equipment is available for league players with the fee being determined on a case-by-case basis. HHA has implemented an Equipment rental deposit (in addition to the rental fee) which will be refunded when the equipment is returned in satisfactory condition. The deposit amount is as follows: Mini Mite \$50; Mite \$50; Squirt \$50; PeeWee \$75; Girls U14 \$75; Bantam \$100; Girls and Boys JV & Varsity \$150. Equipment for older skaters is very limited. Partial equipment rentals are available with fees varying depending on type of equipment rented. Skaters at the PeeWee and older levels are required to provide their own helmet. In order to obtain an HHA team jersey, a post-dated (Jan 31, 2026) deposit check must be given to HHA equipment room personnel. Deposit checks will be returned to skaters upon return of HHA jersey. Deposit fees per skater are \$100 PER JERSEY. (Older levels that have home and away jerseys will pay \$200 total)

Financial Assistance

Our goal is that no child wishing to play hockey be denied the opportunity. Limited funds are available to cover partial or full registration fees (excluding season pass fee), plus assistance toward player's equipment. Funds awarded for registration and equipment are based upon need, financial qualifications and fund availability.
