Jersey Agreement

Home and Away game jerseys are supplied by NLYHA for each player. These jerseys are the property of NLYHA, and players and parents are responsible for proper care and safekeeping of the jerseys.

- Jerseys will be checked out by Equipment Manager to the team and team manager before the team's first game.
- Jerseys are to be turned in by team manager within two weeks from the team's last game of the season.
- Teams desiring to identify captains or alternate captains may do so if no permanent damage is done to the jersey when the patch is removed at the end of the season. No iron on patches, only sew on patches.
- Jerseys will be stored on a hanger. Jerseys are not to be stored in hockey bags due to the risk of cuts from skates and damage from velcro.
- Jerseys are for game wear only and may not be worn for practices. Jerseys can be worn on game days to school and in support of other Northern Lakes Lightning teams (High School Teams included) during District, Regional, or State tournament games.
- At the end of the season when the jerseys are turned in, if a jersey is damaged beyond reasonable wear and tear, cuts, Velcro marks, food or beverage stains, or rust marks from skates, you will be responsible for the cost to repair or replace the jerseys.
- If jerseys are lost you will have to pay for the replacement jerseys. The cost for replacement is \$92.50 per jersey for a total of \$185.
- The equipment manager will have all jerseys inspected before the End of Season Banquet and will inform you of what is owed for the repairs of replacement of the jerseys.
