A Brief History of First Coast Rowing Club

First Coast Rowing Club (FCRC) is a 501(C)(3) founded to introduce the sport of rowing to Jacksonville-area youth and build a community with values that are the essence of the sport: hard work, discipline, and teamwork. What began in 1990 with just a handful of athletes and borrowed equipment has grown into a thriving program that trains students from across the region—usually with no prior experience—to compete at the highest levels of youth rowing and beyond. We proudly boast that over the years, FCRC has become far more than just a youth rowing club—it's a launchpad. Our athletes have gone on to compete for top collegiate programs across the country, from Stanford to Princeton, many earning athletic scholarships and expanding their academic opportunities thanks to the foundation they built here.

Built by Community, Powered by Progress

With the support of donors and local businesses, we've made incredible strides over the years. Most recently:

- A 115-foot boat bay was erected to store our fleet and properly protect our equipment.
- A covered outdoor training area is in development, giving athletes a designated space to build strength and fitness when weather does not allow us to safely practice on the water
- A cargo trailer was recently acquired and being outfitted to better support our team at competitions.
- Higher quality, semi-new boats were acquired, aiding our athletes to bring home 3 National Championship medals in the past two years.


