Texas Rising Stars:

- In addition to regular team practices, 10u and up Goalies who REGISTER for the 3-day option will receive weekly goalie specific training from The HockeyCo and are welcome to also attend the Sunday Power Edge Pro session as a Goalie. So TRS 10u and up Goalies can essentially get 4 days of training.
- To receive this goalie training you must select the 3-day option in your TRS season registration.
