Pomperaug Youth Baseball believes that all children who want to play baseball should be able to do so, regardless of income or ability to pay. That begins with a review of our league fees:

League Fees

We commit to review the registration fees from neighboring towns before every spring season, to confirm that our league fees are in line with other area programs.

Upon setting fees for the upcoming season, we will make available Registration Assistance using the following guidelines:

Assistance Pool

Each Fall and Spring season, PYB will establish an assistance pool equal to 5% of our player registrations for that season, in the median dollar amount of league fees. For example, if we have 200 players register in the Spring, the assistance pool for that season will be \$1,300 (5% of 200, multiplied by \$130, the AAA and median fee).

Division of the Pool

After registration closes, PYB will divide the pool by the number of applicants, and reduce registration fees by that amount. In the example above, if we have 13 players apply for assistance, they will have their registration fees reduced by \$100 (\$1,300 divided by 13 players).

Application and Confidentiality

Registration Assistance is a need-blind program. We will never ask for "proof" of need. By simply asking for assistance, players will be entered in the pool. Families with multiple players will be considered as one applicant, unless we have a low number of applicants, in which case we will try to fund each player's registration separately.

Requests for Registration Assistance will be kept confidential, and will only be shared between the Registrar and League President or Vice President, for the purposes of updating the registration system and processing the request.
