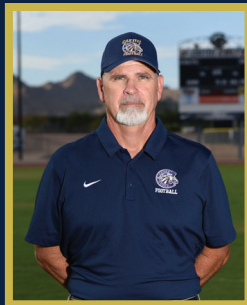

VARSITY OFFENSIVE LINE COACH

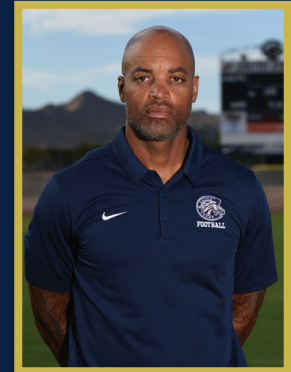

VARSITY STC / K COACH

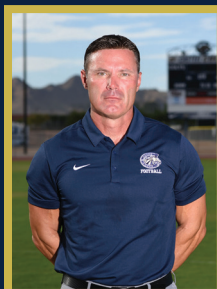
