



IRONMAN 70.3 STAFFORDSHIRE ROAD ACCESS INFORMATION – SUNDAY 7 JUNE 2020

NEWBOROUGH, NEEDWOOD, HANBURY, DRAYCOTT IN THE CLAY, STUBBY LANE, MARCHINGTON & KINGSTONE

Temporary road closures will be in place for IRONMAN 70.3 Staffordshire race day (Sunday 7 June) to ensure the safety of athletes and the public. These legal road closures are implemented under the Road Traffic Regulation (Special Events) Act 1994, and apply to all vehicles and bikes that are not involved in the event. Please use this information to plan your journey in advance, and to minimise the inconvenience to your travel on race day.

- Please avoid parking on any section of the bike course for safety reasons.
- Pedestrians can cross the course at any time when safe to do so.
- Essential access for carers will be facilitated. Please contact staffordshire70.3@ironmanroadaccess.com as early as possible.
- There are **NO RESTRICTIONS** at any time to any of the emergency services
- **DETOUR ADVICE:** The A518, A34, A38, A511, and A50 are unaffected. Travel to Stafford and Rugeley is possible at all times via these routes.

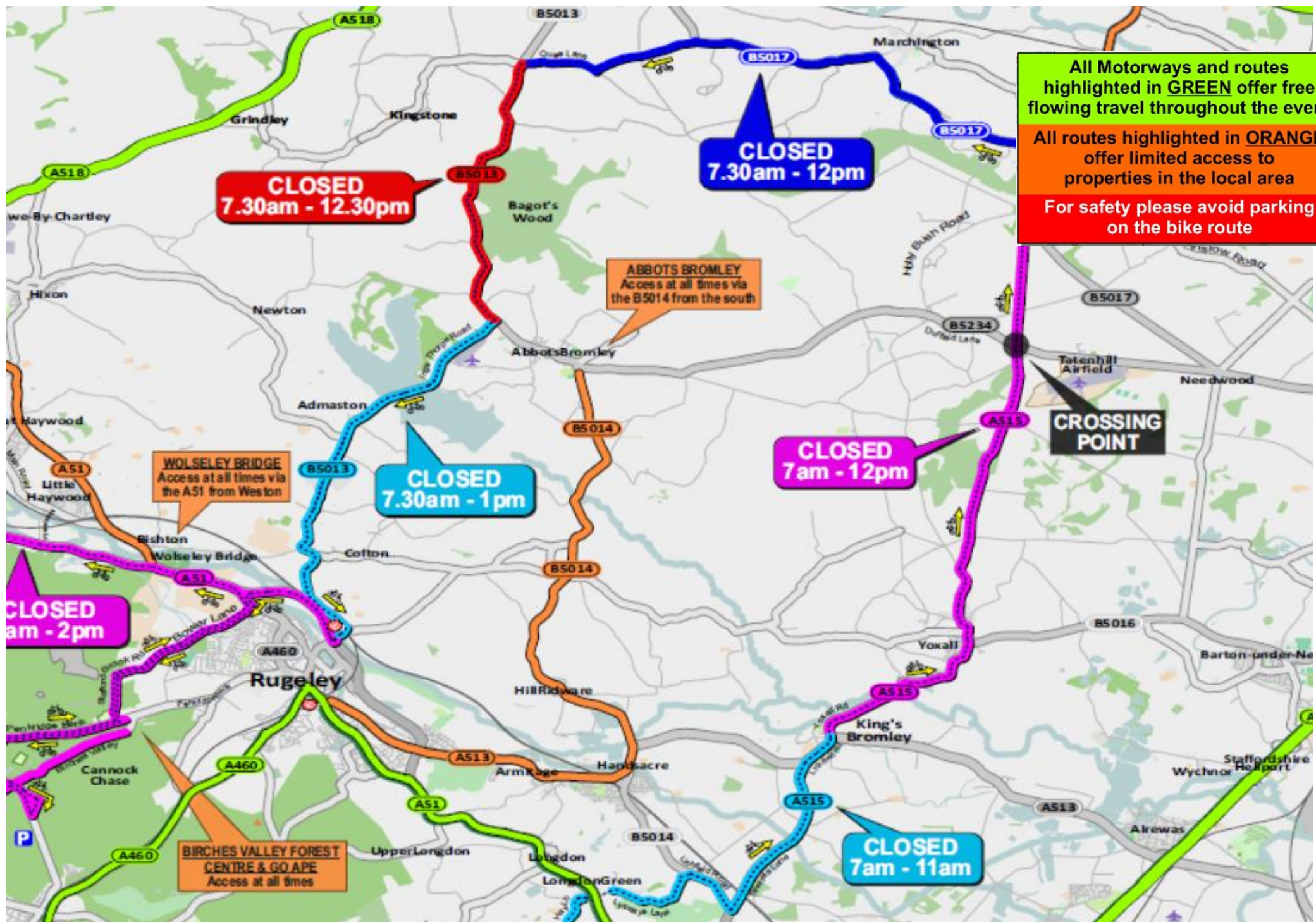
AREA	CLOSURES	DETAILS
NEWBOROUGH NEEDWOOD HANBURY	07:00 to 12:00	<p>The bike course will continue north from Yoxall on the A515 before turning left onto the B5017/Stubby Lane at Draycott in the Clay. This is a slight course change from previous years.</p> <p>The A515 will be closed between 07:00 – 12:00. Residents should also be aware of road closures to the west along the B5013.</p> <p>ACCESS ADVICE: There will be access south at all times via B5014 to connect to the A51 and Rugeley. The A515 south of Kings Bromley will reopen at 11:00. See Map.</p>
DRAYCOTT IN THE CLAY	07:00 to 12:00	<p>The bike course then turns left onto Stubby Lane. The A515 will be closed south of Draycott in the Clay between 07:00 – 12:00. The B5017 (Stubby Lane) is also closed 07:30 – 12:00.</p> <p>ACCESS ADVICE: There will be residential and business access at all times north of the Stubby Lane/Greaves Lane junction via the A515 from the north. Access to Greaves Lane will be available throughout the day, but no southbound travel will be possible beyond this point. The A50 and A511 allow travel as normal at all times.</p>
STUBBY LANE	07:30 to 12:00	<p>The bike course will continue along the B5017 from Draycott in the Clay to join the B5013. The B5017 Stubby Lane will be closed to vehicle access from 07:30 – 12:00 to ensure the safety of athletes and residents.</p> <p>ACCESS ADVICE: Residents are advised to take this into consideration when planning their journeys, and to pre-plan for alternative parking locations or travel times. See Map.</p>
MARCHINGTON	07:30 to 12:00	<p>The bike course will then skirt around Marchington to the south west along Stubby Lane (B5017). There are closures on Stubby Lane between 07:30 – 12:00 and on the A515 south of Draycott in the Clay until 12:00.</p> <p>ACCESS ADVICE: There is access from the north via Moisty Lane. See Map.</p>
