## USA Softball Age Classification - NEW 2024

Our 10U, 12U, and 14U teams participate in the South Central WI Girls Softball League. This league complies with the rules of USA Softball. USA Softball changed the age classification rules effective for the 2024 season.

A player's age as of August 31, 2023 is the determining date for age level classification.

The purpose of this rule change was to align age classification in a manner consistent with the player's grade level in school.

## Age Level Expectations - 8U

- League Type: In-House (Practice and Scrimmage)
- Age (Season Sep 1, 2023 - Aug 31, 2024): Birth Date 9/1/2014 and After (Player Must Be in Kindergarten)
- Practices: 1 per week for 60-90 minutes
- Location: Waubesa Intermediate School (Grass Area or Fields When Available)
- Ball Size: 11 " softie
- Pitching: Tee / Coach Pitch - No strikeouts
- Batting: Continuous, Bat Around
- Field Play: Maximum of 1 inning per position
- Infield vs. Outfield: Equal
- Playing Time: Equal
- Required Equipment: Glove ( $10^{\prime \prime}-11^{\prime \prime}$ ), Athletic Shoes, Water Bottle
- Optional Equipment: Bat (Fast Pitch ASA Approved), Helmet w/ Face Mask, Fielder's Mask, Batting Gloves, Equipment Bag


## Age Level Expectations - 10U

- League Type: South Central League
- Age (Season Sep 1, 2023 - Aug 31, 2024): Birth Date Between 9/1/2012 and 8/31/2014
- Practices: $1-2$ per week starting in May for 60-90 minutes
- Games: 1-2 per week starting in June for 90 minutes, 7-innings or run rule, arrive 1 hour before game
- Location: Waubesa Intermediate School and surrounding communities
- Ball Size: $11^{\prime \prime}$
- Pitching: Player
- Batting: Continuous, 3 outs or 5 run rule
- Field Play: Free substitution, may play same position for 1-2 innings
- Infield vs. Outfield: Minimum 1 infield inning guaranteed
- Playing Time: Equal and fair based on attitude and attendance
- Required Equipment: Glove (11" $-12^{\prime \prime}+$ ), Cleats (No Metal), Fielder's Mask, Uniform, Navy Blue Long Softball Socks, Grey Softball Pants, Water Bottle
- Suggested Equipment: Equipment Bag, Helmet w/ Face Mask, Sliding Shorts, Belt, Sport Sunglasses
- Optional Equipment: Bat (Fast Pitch ASA Approved), Batting Gloves


## Age Level Expectations - 12U

- League Type: South Central League
- Age (Season Sep 1, 2023 - Aug 31, 2024): Birth Date Between 9/1/2010 and 8/31/2012
- Practices: 1-2 per week starting in May for 60-90 minutes
- Games: 1-2 per week starting in June for 90 minutes, 7 -innings or run rule, arrive 1 hour before game
- Location: Waubesa Intermediate School and surrounding communities
- Ball Size: 12"
- Pitching: Player
- Batting: Continuous, 3 outs or 8 run rule
- Field Play: Free substitution, may play same position for 2-3 innings
- Playing Time: Not equal but fair based on ability, attitude and attendance
- Required Equipment: Glove (12"+), Cleats (No Metal), Fielder's Mask, Uniform, Navy Blue Long Softball Socks, Grey Softball Pants, Water Bottle
- Suggested Equipment: Equipment Bag, Helmet w/ Face Mask, Sliding Shorts, Belt, Sport Sunglasses
- Optional Equipment: Bat (Fast Pitch ASA Approved), Batting Gloves


## Age Level Expectations - 14U

- League Type: South Central League
- Age (Season Sep 1, 2023 - Aug 31, 2024): Birth Date Between 9/1/2008 and 8/31/2010
- Practices: $1-2$ per week starting in May for 60-90 minutes
- Games: $1-2$ per week starting in June for 90 minutes, 7 -innings or run rule, arrive 1 hour before game
- Location: Waubesa Intermediate School and surrounding communities
- Ball Size: 12"
- Pitching: Player
- Batting: Standard 9-Player + DP/Flex or Continuous, 3 outs
- Field Play: NFHS/WIAA or free substitution, may play same position for whole game
- Playing Time: Not equal but fair based on ability, attitude and attendance
- Required Equipment: Glove (12"+), Cleats (Metal is permitted), Fielder's Mask, Uniform, Navy Blue Long Softball Socks, Grey Softball Pants, Water Bottle
- Suggested Equipment: Equipment Bag, Helmet w/ Face Mask, Sliding Shorts, Belt, Sport Sunglasses
- Optional Equipment: Bat (Fast Pitch ASA Approved), Batting Gloves
